“We are very excited about this partnership.” Cathy Sanz, President of WIFLE said. “It’s not just about the reduced tuition and fees, or the fact that Excelsior College accepts more credits than most other institutions, but also that WIFLE members will now be able to easily fit a degree program into their busy law enforcement schedules through the Excelsior distance learning programs. “
