

Catrina M. Bonus is a retired United States Secret Service (USSS) executive with over 26 years of federal law enforcement experience. Mrs. Bonus began her career with the Secret Service in September 1996. She progressed steadily through the ranks holding positions at the White House Branch, the Naval Observatory Branch, the Foreign Missions Branch, the Special Operations Branch, the Office of the Chief, and the James J. Rowley Training Center. As the 1st female deputy chief in Uniformed Division history, Mrs. Bonus oversaw a diverse workforce of over 700 law enforcement professionals and led the strategic development, implementation, and management of security policies and daily operations for the White

House Complex. Before her retirement in January 2023, Mrs. Bonus was assigned to the James J. Rowley Training Center in Laurel, Maryland, where she supervised personnel in 3 locations and maintained compliance with federal law enforcement training requirements. She provided oversight of all basic and advanced training needs, supporting the Secret Service protective and investigative mission and personnel professional growth worldwide. Mrs. Bonus oversaw the day-to-day administrative and operational functions of the Secret Service training facility and managed a \$51M annual budget that supported agency priorities, facility enhancements, staffing, technology improvements, business opportunities, and strategic planning.

Mrs. Bonus graduated Magna Cum Laude with a Bachelor of Science degree in Criminal Justice from Liberty University, located in Lynchburg, VA. She also earned a Master of Arts degree in Human Services Counseling: Criminal Justice from Liberty University. Mrs. Bonus is a graduate of the National Defense University, Dwight D. Eisenhower School for National Security and Resource Strategy, where she earned a Master of Science degree in National Resource Strategy with an Ethics Concentration. Mrs. Bonus also participated in the Key Executive Leadership Certificate Program at American University and was the first Uniformed Division member to be accepted into the USSS SES Candidate Development Program.

Mrs. Bonus is a member of Women in Federal Law Enforcement, the International Association of Chiefs of Police, and the Federal Law Enforcement Officers Association. Mrs. Bonus serves as an Executive Committee Member for the Honor Every Responsible Officer's Eternal Sacrifice (HEROES) Inc. Golf Committee.

In February 2023, Mrs. Bonus was named President of the WIFLE Foundation, Inc. and Executive Director of Women in Federal Law Enforcement, Inc. She looks forward to supporting and advocating for all women in federal law enforcement and confronting the many challenges women face in this demanding profession.

Mrs. Bonus is married to Brian Bonus, a USSS Supervisory Special Agent assigned to the Baltimore Field Office. They have a beautiful and funny 11-year-old daughter and two energetic two-year-old pups.
